The Iowa Juvenile Home Foundation was created in 1996 as a nonprofit organization to assist the staff and residents of the Juvenile Home beyond what the State of Iowa can provide.

The IJH Foundation sponsors an annual appreciation of staff members and provides funds for staff training and awards.

Residents receive personal items as gifts at Christmas time, certainly a lonely time to spend in an institution away from family and friends. IJH Foundation also pays for special Christmas party favors and food.

The IJH library was remodeled and upgraded in 2004 with computerized cataloging and internet access, and continues to be stocked with new books and magazines.

A traveling art display began in October 2005 to show off the students' work in art class, and will eventually be retired at Drake University in Des Moines.

In 2006, the Foundation obtained a grant to upgrade the science and reading rooms in the high school.

We also sponsor a music therapy program during after-school hours. A music therapist visits the institution once a week. Boys and girls are getting guitar lessons and are enthusiastic about occasional professional music concerts in house.
