#### DID YOU Know...

- Iowa Correctional Institution for Women (ICIW) is the only correctional facility for women in Iowa.
- There are over 540 residents at ICIW while it was designed to house 455 residents.
- Female offenders are the fastest growing offender population in Iowa.
- Recent improvements to ICIW will increase the capacity to 888 beds.
- Over 250 residents have one or more minor children.
- 68% of Iowa's female offenders are nonviolent offenders and will return to their home communities and families.
- Offenders with positive family and community support are less likely to re-offend.
- ICIW's visiting room is open 30 hours per week and will be relocated in October to expanded space.
- Research demonstrates that social support is a vital component in preventing women from re-offending.
- Maintaining family contacts through onsite visiting is an important factor in reentry to the community.
